Risk Management Strategies	Normal Operations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Primary students must wear labels with name and school for easy identification. * We recommend a maximum group size of 60 and adult to child ratios appropriate to the age group. * There are trained First Aid staff stationed around Eureka Skydeck 88. * Eureka Skydeck 88 staff have been trained to recognize and assist guests in distress. * We encourage high adult to student ratios for special needs groups. Carers are free of charge. * All areas of Eureka Skydeck 88 are accessible by wheelchair, and bathroom facilities are available. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Teachers must accompany groups of students to ensure excess movement does not interfere with the elevators. * All elevators have two way communication. * Emergency response staff are trained to facilitate speedy and safe release in the event of any elevator malfunction. * Stairwells may also be used for evacuation in emergency situations. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> * The School Bus drop off point is a high traffic area. Please ensure that your students are accompanied by an adult. * Eureka Skydeck 88 is equipped with a state of the art fire safety system to rapidly detect and contain fire. * Access to external areas of Eureka Skydeck 88 is strictly controlled. Guests are not admitted to these areas. * Eureka Skydeck 88 is built to withstand extremely high winds.
